Kioloa Summer Harp Course

What to expect...

The Master Class Course includes daily half-hour individual lessons in an open master class setting, with some ensemble playing, and an opportunity to workshop aspects of harp playing such as relaxation, sound production and repertoire. There will be an informal concert on January 23rd. The course is open to all levels of proficiency from beginner to advanced. Participants for the Master Classes should bring their own harps if possible, or arrange to share. Please contact Alice Giles prior to registration to enquire about the use of a rental harp (limited availability). Participants arrive January 16th and depart January 24th 2010.

The Teaching Course includes seminars and group workshops on aspects of teaching the harp, focusing on how to start beginners on the harp. This includes selecting repertoire, teaching basic technique, and teaching group classes. Participants will receive a certificate from the Harp Centre Australia. Participants who have completed the 2009 course will have the opportunity to build on what they have learnt and further improve their teaching. Participants arrive January 13th and depart January 16th 2010.

Accommodation: The course is set in idyllic coastal surroundings near Bawley Point on the NSW South Coast, just 30 minutes north of Batemans Bay. Accommodation is in double rooms, in newly renovated self-contained cottages with their own kitchen, dining and bathroom facilities. Catering for dinner on alternate nights is included in the course. On other nights, nearby towns have supplies for you to cook for yourself or restaurants for the essential fish 'n chips. Accommodation is possible on application for accompanying parents and partners. From each cottage it is a short walk, past paddocks, kangaroos and forest to the beach.
